If you are successful you will be offered Exhibiting Membership. In the first instance this is for one year, after which your application will be reviewed. If the review is successful you will be granted full Exhibiting Membership.

The subscription is £48 and there is a brochure levy of £10. The levy would not apply until the next Brochure.
